Background



- There are insufficient online open access resources catering for African language literacy pedagogy.
- Molteno recognised the need for properly graded reading materials that are developed in accordance with African language structures.
- With the support of the Zenex Foundation, Molteno has made its innovative *Vula Bula* programme available as an Open Educational Resource that can be wholly accessed via the *Vula Bula* website <u>www.vulabula.co.za</u>





It encompasses all but one of South Africa's indigenous African languages:

Vula means 'open' in **isiXhosa**, **isiZulu**, **isiNdebele**, **Siswati** and **Tshivenda** (and means "speak" in Xitsonga)

bula means 'open' in Setswana, Sesotho and Sepedi

Our hope is that children will **open** books for purposes of reading and writing, and at the same time **open** their minds to the purpose of books and lifelong learning.

Vula Bula is the first graded reading programme in African languages where progression from level to level is based on the phonics of each language.


