Step 3: Compete with your peers, to learn and win

Each of the micro-challenges has been developed according to an exciting theme, across FinTech, Digital Biology, the Internet of Things, 3D printing, Cryptocurrencies and Artificial Intelligence. These themes have been specifically crafted to introduce you to critical skills that will give you a head start in tomorrow's business context.

Added to this, you'll earn points with every challenge you complete and the leader-board features the top participating schools and students online each week.
